Key Concepts:

- 5S is a beginning/intermediate level course which teaches participants the value proposition of 5S through hands-on implementation in a real work environment. It is suitable for participants who work in office or manufacturing environments, but the specific area of focus during this Kaizen style workshop will be in operations. Topics covered include:
 - Understanding that 5S is a problem exposure tool
 - Defining the 5 S's (plus Safety)
 - Documenting the current state, using the DOWNTIME concept to identify waste
 - Planning a 5S event (event definition, leadership roles, steps for planning and executing the event)
 - Putting the 5S into action
 - Establishing visual controls, documenting standards, creating an audit process
